A Listening Church About the Synodal Process, Pope Francis says “*It’s not about gathering opinions, no. This is not a survey, but about listening to the Holy Spirit...*” Each parish is asked to identify two parishioners who will take on the role of Parish Coordinators for the Synod parish consultation process. The Parish Priest will work closely with the coordinators, who are asked to attend a day long workshop on the Synodal Process at Burn Hall on Saturday 6 November from 10.00am to 3.00pm. The process of Parishioners listening to each other is really very simple!

.Please let me know if you would like to be a Parish Co-ordinator as soon as possible so that I can let the Bishop’s Secretary know by 31st October. .Registration forms need to be returned by 1st November For further information see the website for Catholic Bishops’ Conference of England and Wales “Approaches to the Synodal Pathway”. If possible, the Parish Coordinators should be a man and a woman. Be prepared to work closely with the parish priest .Be good listeners, able to engage with people from different backgrounds . Be able to make accurate and concise notes. Much of the Synodal process will be explained at Burn Hall on Saturday 6th November.
