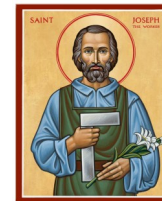

Readers: just a couple of reminders:
we don't start moving to the Lectern to
read until the Collect is concluded, but for
the Bidding Prayers please move to the
Lectern as the congregation say
"I believe in one Holy, Catholic,.... in the
Creed. The reader remains at the Lectern
till the priest has concluded the prayer.
The introduction to each reading is as
given in the Lectionary, so its not
necessary to say First Reading or Second
Reading.
