Pocklington Extra-ordinary Ministers of the Eucharist, can we meet after the Mass you usually attend this weekend (13th/14th Sept). If any ministers from MW have moved to Mass at Pocklington, please also attend. We will discuss some of the practicalities of Pocklington Church. Guidance on usual practice for Ministers changed a few years ago, the Extra-ordinary Minister approaches the Altar after the priest has received Holy Communion not before, and though the ministers with the Chalice, still consume from the Chalice after they have administered it, they then return the Chalice to the Altar for the priest to cleanse.

Readers: just a couple of reminders: we don't start moving to the Lectern to read until the Collect is concluded, but for the Bidding Prayers please move to the Lectern as the congregation say "I believe in one Holy, Catholic,.... in the Creed. The reader remains at the Lectern till the priest has concluded the prayer. The introduction to each reading is as given in the Lectionary, so its not necessary to say First Reading or Second Reading.
